Re: Rate for Subscriber Activated Call Blocking Feature

We write with reference to the subject matter and further to Orders No. 2 and 4 of 2017 as noted by the Public Utilities Commission ('PUC').

We hereby request the implementation of rate for call blocking feature to take effect as of October 1, 2018. The call blocking feature allows for customers to be able to prevent calls from being made from landlines to other numbers. The features provide a variety of options to the Customer. GTT offers several levels of protection which subscriber chooses upon subscription for the service.

1.	All	-	The customer is prompted for PIN whenever any call is made. Except
			emergency calls.
2.	Toll	-	Customer is prompted for a PIN whenever TOLL calls are made (Toll is an out
			of exchange call). Emergency is exempted.
3.	International Calls	-	Customer prompted for PIN when an international direct dialing calls made.
4.	Cellular Calls	× •-	Customer is prompted to provide a pin before cellular calls can be made.
5.	900 Calls		Customer is prompted to provide a pin before 900 calls can be made

In light of the forgoing, GTT is proposing that this rate of Three Hundred and Ten Guyanese Dollars (GY\$ 310.00) per month for the usage of the feature for each customer.
